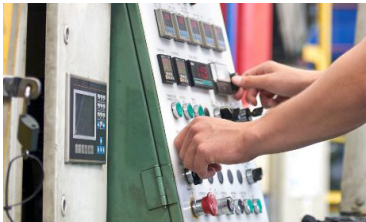

AAFCO is a voluntary membership association of local, state, and federal agencies which contributes to pet food safety by:

- Setting nutritional guidelines for pet food
- Developing model regulations guidelines for use by state and federal
- Establishing ingredient definitions and label standards

The State Department of Agriculture often use AAFCO's guidelines as a baseline when creating the pet food regulations for their individual state.

**The Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA)** was signed in as a federal law which enables the FDA to better regulate pet food manufacturers and suppliers by standardizing food safety requirements.

Pet food manufacturers are required to develop and implement a written food safety plan
